

## **Fly of the Month:**

### **Marabou Spider**

Hook Size: 2 to 0/2

Body: Floss Body

Rib: Silver/gold oval tinsel

Wing: Dark colored marabou over light colored marabou

Hackle: guinea or saddle hackle

Thread: black or matching last wrap

~ The Marabou spider and its variants are very popular with northwest winter Steelheaders. With its big profile and undulating characteristics it will give you the confidence to fully expect a take with every swing of your fly. Take special care when wrapping the marabou plumes (tip first). After every wrap comb through the barbules with your bodkin, this will get rid of any tangles in your final product. Mix and match colors, be creative, have fun!
