President's Report - The February, 2025 BOD meeting was 'Called to Order' at: 6:30 p.m. by Jared Wood

The following agenda items were discussed:

- Joint event with PHW at Munn Lake on Feb 15th
 - We will be providing 3-4 boats to take veterans out
 - 1-2 other Board members would be beneficial to help with breakfast burritos. Request made that SSFF purchase food for this event. Bruce Lincoln made a motion to approve. Veronica Smolen seconded. Vote by BOD was unanimously approved.
 - SSFF Banner and Signs
- Feb 22nd Outing at Steamboat Island (Low tide starts 10:45AM and6:33PM, 9.39 ft)
 - Start time of 12 and lunch first then fish.
 - What food do we want to cook: Max will bring chili dogs/hamburgers. BOD members bring sides. Meet at 10:00 to set up.
 - Members who want to attend recommend meeting at Griffin Fire Station. Who can drive the shuttle from fire house? (I didn't get who volunteered for this...)
 - Let Jared know if you have boat that can go in salt water!
- Fly Fisher of the Year Award for 2024 discussion on more than one award & vote: Agreed only one award at this time. Nominations were reviewed and award recipient unanimously agreed on.
- Mentorship Program Committee: Max reaching out to other clubs to see if they will share how their mentorship programs work. Also developing new member welcome packets and would like to include a history of the SSFF club. Suggested he contact Kevin Ryan for history.
- 2024 Financial Audit Committee: Agreed we will meet February 28 at 11:00 for lunch and audit review.
 Jared will confirm location.
- Recommendation to change the By-Laws (see new proposed language below) to add Mentorship as standing Committee. Discussion and Jared called for a motion to approve. Vic Andrade motioned to approve, Max seconded. Vote to approve was unanimous. Update to include review and communication with membership.

Article IV: Officers and their Election

Section 5 The President shall preside at all meetings of the South Sound Fly Fishers and the Board of Directors and shall perform such duties as usually pertain to the office of the President of similar organizations. The President shall appoint the pertinent chair positions amongst the elected officers and/or directors to address issues of interest to the club including Conservation, Education, Programs, Outings, Newsletter, Membership, Mentorship, and Webmaster.

Article VI: Board of Directors

Section 1 The Board of Directors shall consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, the immediate Past President, Directors-at-large, and the Chairs for Conservation, Education, Fly Fishers International, Fundraising, Membership, Mentorship, Newsletter, Outings, Programs, and Webmaster/Media positions. The duties and responsibilities of the Directors-at-large shall be determined by the President. When the SSFF is not in session, all powers of the SSFF shall be vested in the Board of Directors. Matters pertaining to policies, management, and administration of SSFF shall be referred to the Board of Directors before being acted upon by the SSFF.

Committee Reports

1. Treasurer: Lee

2025 Budget Review and Vote to approve. Lee reviewed 2025 budget with BOD. After discussion Jared called for motion to approve: Vic Andrade motioned, Mike Clancy seconded. BOD unanimously approved.

Action item: Lee will call Greg Shimek, Coastal Cutthroat Coalition, and talk with him regarding \$320.00 donation and report back to BOD. This money was targeted for them, but they declined our offer years ago

2. Conservation: Tim
