President's Report – The BOD meeting was 'Called to Order' at: 6:33 by Jared Wood

- Club Picnic Planning Tuesday August 19 at Scott Lake. This is the August general meeting,

- Rod building class update Jared met with a Lacey non-profit "OFOH" (Outdoors for Our Heroes) that teaches rod building in one day. Class is free for military veterans. Other students pay \$120 to build a trout fly rod.
 - They will give SSFF six seats in the class. Let Jared know your interest.

Committee Reports

- 1. Treasurer: Lee Reviewed financials from the June auction. We netted \$3,242 which was more than our 2023 auction. He renewed the CD on July 31 for another 7 months; it will mature February 2026. It was \$10,706 at maturity. He will provide more recommendations for the CD in Jan / Feb 2026.
- **2. Conservation: Tim V.** Chum Trap setup by Hood Canal Salmon Enhancement Group (HCSEG). Volunteer spots were filled quickly, this is a very popular activity. Those still interested should check the HCSEG web-site as volunteers may drop out and their slots will become available to others.
 - The Pebble Mine project had planned to appeal the denial with the new EPA, but any such appeal would be expected to be denied again. Mike Clancy said the fish counts returning to Bristol Bay are very solid.

- 3. Education: Randy: Fly Tying dates published on the Parks and Rec registration website were not as we requested. Randy is communicating with Parks Dept. to figure out the class dates (room availability at the Center?) This made the Education article for the Hackle "iffy." Getting cost estimates for materials for the tying class. Have some leftover materials from last year.
 - Printing costs The city informed us they can no longer offer free printing. We would like to continue printing through the Parks Dept., so we're exploring options with them.
- **4. FFI: Mike** FFI Fly-Fest event September 26-27 in Grand Rapids, MI. A lucky attendee will win a drift boat and trailer. FFI noted that attendee registrations were low, and they're having difficulty getting demo tyers.
- **5. Fundraising: Kevin** Absent no report.
- **6. Membership: Phil** 94 paid members, 34 new members in 2025. Phil questioned how to retain our new members. The Mentorship program should be a big help. Attendance increased at recent outings. Phil showed a new member notebook which will include their patch, badge, the by-laws, and a mentorship application.
- 7. Mentorship: Tim B. Jared filled in. The Mentorship committee will meet this Thursday, August 14 with a goal to announce the program at the picnic.
- 8. Newsletter: Dave Discussion about for-sale-by-member ads in the newsletter. Seller must be a paid member. Dave referred to a Fundraising article about a year ago. BOD agreed to retain the suggestion for seller to donate 20% of the proceeds to the club for publishing the ad. The 20% donation should be made via PayPal or other donation means on the website. The new article (Aug Hackle) will not be under Kevin's fundraising page.
- 9. Outings: Jesse (taken from the Agenda) Pink Salmon Outing in Aug/Sep? Camping in Yakima for Sep outing-get with Max/Bruce (need numbers of participants).
 Randy will contact Sage rod manufacturing on Bainbridge Island to inquire about tours they offer. A number of members indicated interest in this trip.
